## Did you know?

Dust mites are insects too tiny to see with the human eye. They are found in every home. Dust mites can trigger asthma and allergies.

## Action Plan

- ☐ Dust mites live in carpets, bedding, upholstered furniture, and stuffed toys. You can take these steps to limit exposure:
  - Use zippered dust-proof covers on pillows, mattresses, and box springs.
  - Wash sheets and blankets weekly.
  - Wash stuffed toys regularly. If they cannot be washed, keep them out of sleeping areas.
  - Vacuum floors and fabric-covered furniture regularly. If possible, use a vacuum with a high-efficiency particulate air (HEPA) filter.
- □ Dust mites thrive with humidity:
  - Use an air conditioner or dehumidifier to decrease humidity in your home.
