CLINICAL CONSULTATIONS

For patients, parents, educators, and health care professionals who may contact our experts on issues concerning children's environmental health. We have a multidisciplinary team including respiratory therapist, social worker and nutritionist to assure complete assessment and clinical care. We are developing a telehealth program to assure that patients in the most remote locations in our region can avail themselves of our consultations.
