

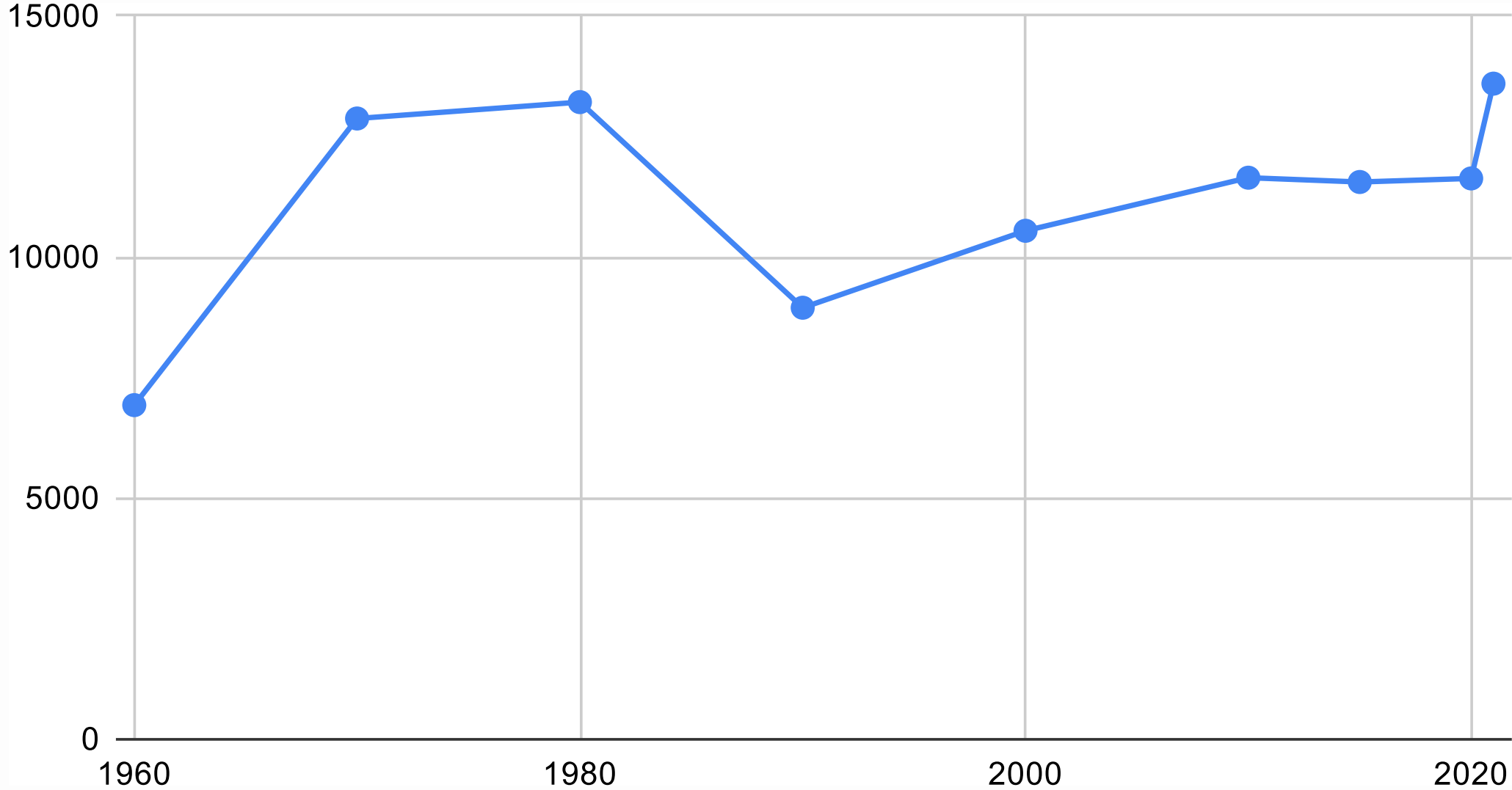

# POPULATION GROWTH

11,647 -> 13,598

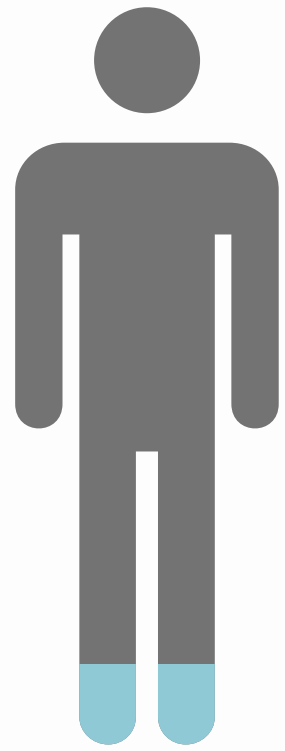
**Babylon Town**

1,482,548 -> 1,522,998

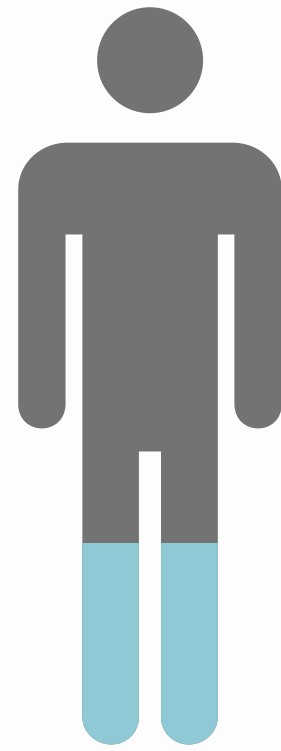
Wyandanch's population increased by almost 2,000 individuals (2010-2021), accounting for almost half the Town of Babylon's population growth and 5% of Suffolk County's growth.

# ECONOMIC / NUTRITIONAL AID

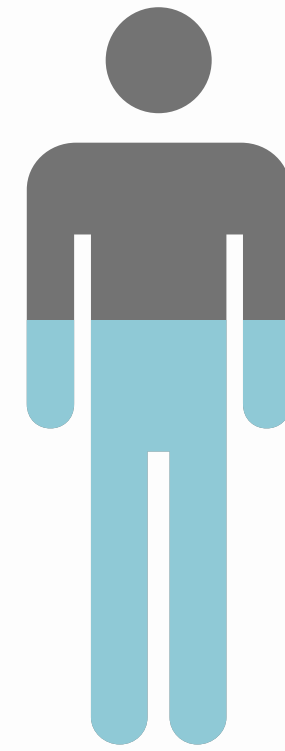
Percentage of households receiving economic/nutritional aid

New York State: **25.8%**

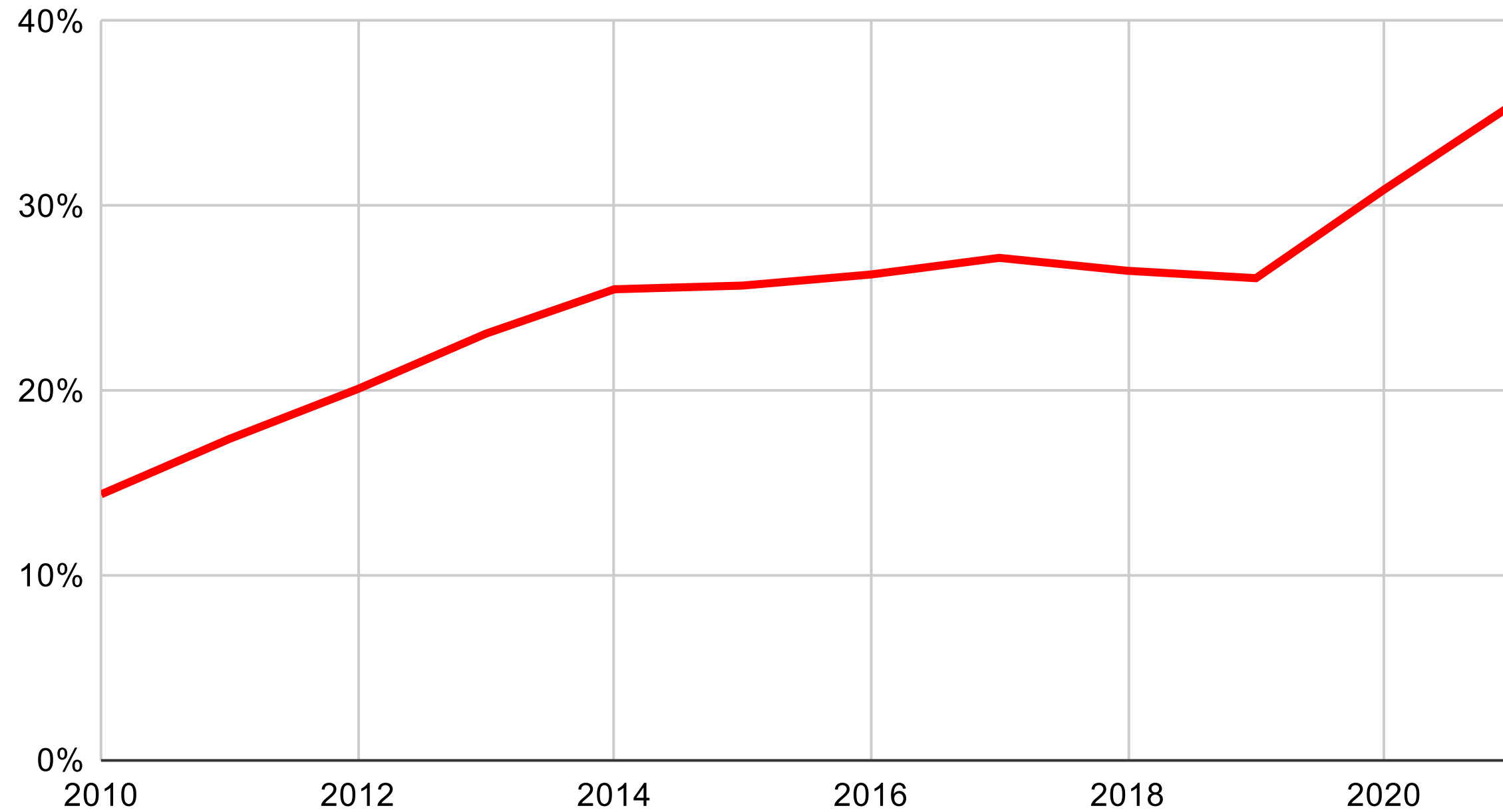


Wyandanch: **47.6%**

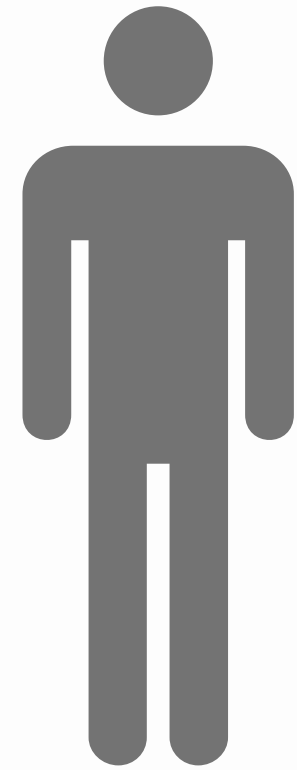
Percentage of Households Which Receive Food Aid Over Time in Wyandanch



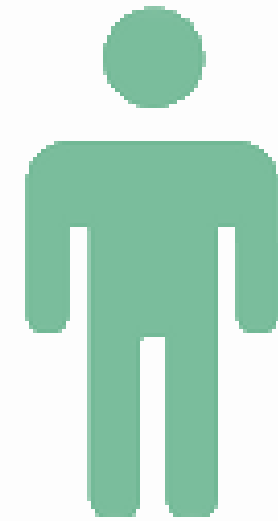
The percentage of households receiving food aid in Wyandanch is rising (2010-2021).

# FOOD AID IN 2021

Percent of households receiving food aid

With Children:  
**13.5%**

A large proportion of adults and children received food aid in Wyandanch in 2021. (In Suffolk County 3.6% of households without children and 2.2% of households with children receive food aid.) Low and moderate income families have a greater need for food aid. Food insecurity disproportionately harms communities of color in the United States.

Wyandanch: \$75,216

Suffolk: \$111,660

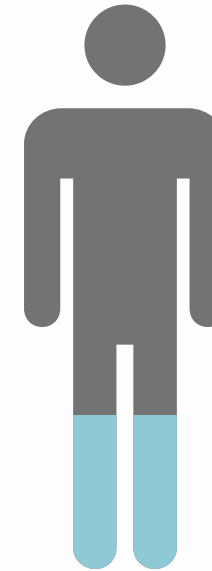
Median household income in Wyandanch increased from \$54,052 to \$75,216 between 2010 and 2021; this is comparable to New York State but less than Suffolk County.

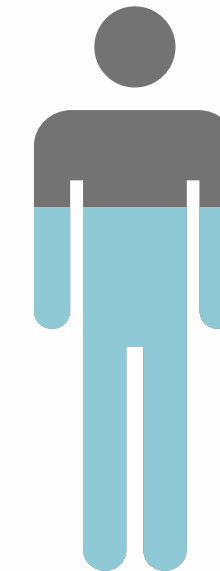
## Percentage of the Population Living in Poverty

## Percentage of the Population with a High School Diploma or Higher

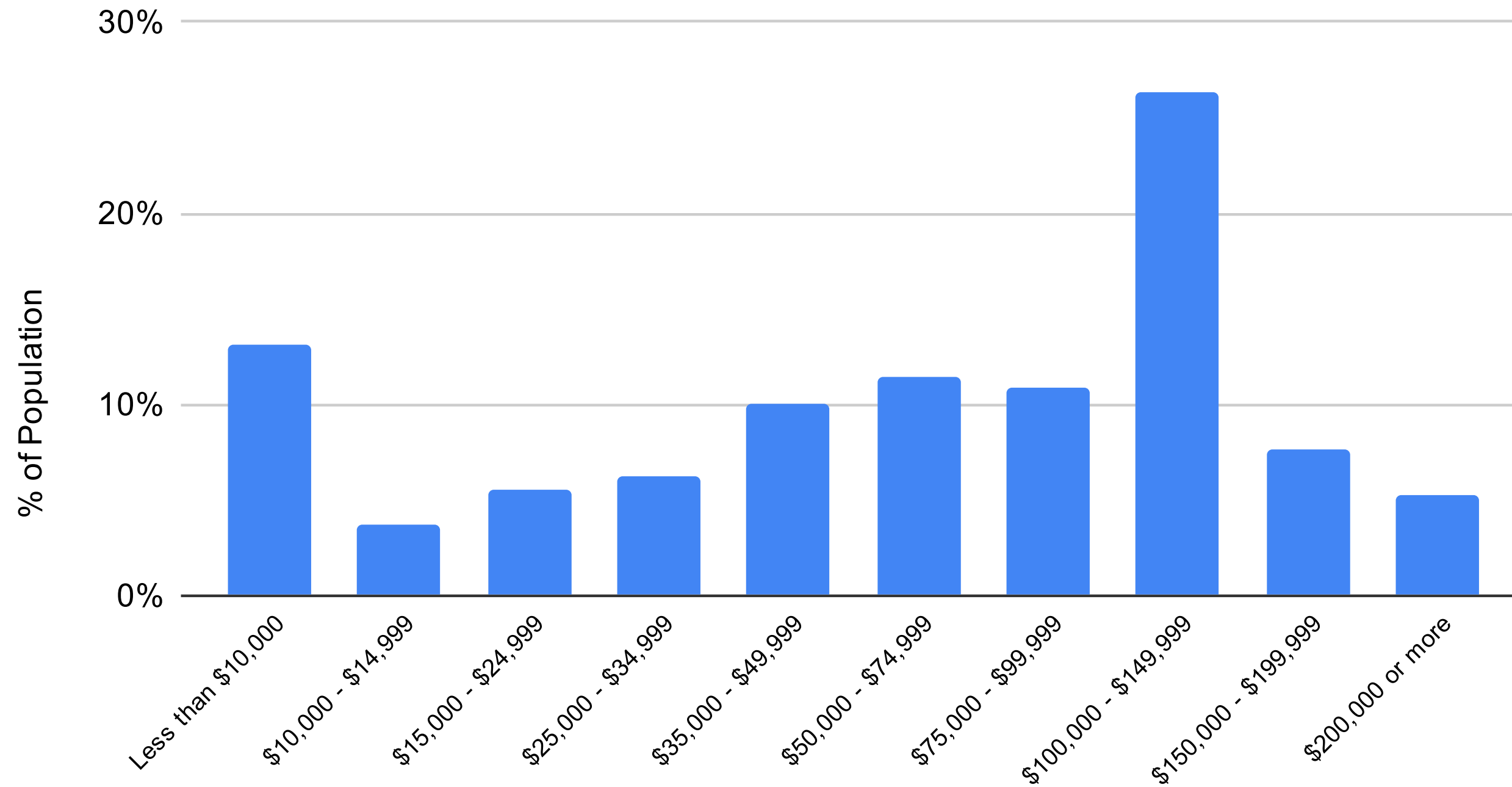
72.2% -> 66.9%

# INCOME DISTRIBUTION, 2021

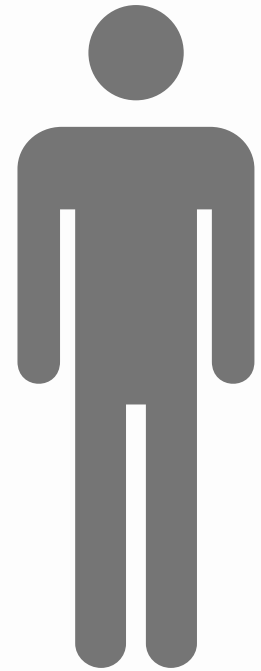
Wyandanch Income by Bracket



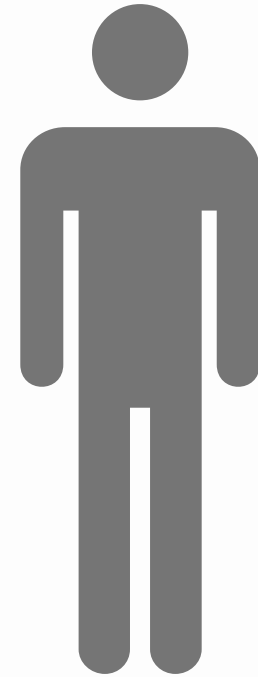
The two largest income categories are \$100,000-\$149,999 and less than \$10,000.



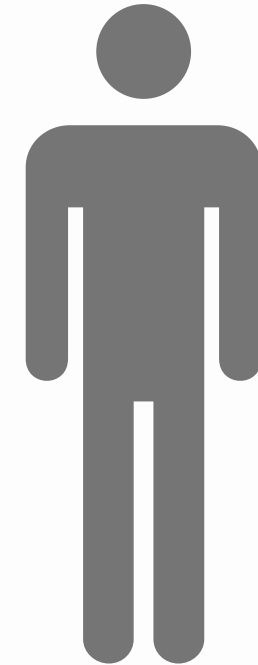
# RACE AND ETHNICITY



**Black or African American:**  
**65% -> 56.9%**



**Hispanic or Latino of any Race:**  
**28.2% -> 37.1%**



**White (Non-Hispanic):**  
**16.4% -> 2.2%**

Between 2010 and 2021, there has been a large decrease in the percentage of Black or African American individuals and White, non-Hispanic individuals in Wyandanch. Meanwhile, there has been an increase in the percentage of Hispanic or Latino individuals.

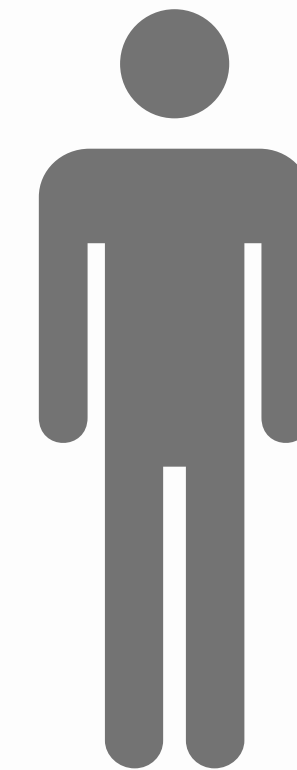
## Percentage of the Population Foreign Born
